1. All cattle to be on the grounds no later than 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, September 10, 2009. It is suggested where possible animals should be in the barns on Wednesday, September 9 in order to facilitate preparation of animals for the show.
2. All animals exhibited must be purebred or 75% registered or greater and recorded on the records of the Holstein Association of Canada in the name of the exhibitor. (No animal can be shown on a signed transfer of ownership).
3. Each animal will be checked against its pedigree prior to entry into the ring.
4. The judge will be asked to give reasons on the top 3 or 4 animals.
5. No bedding will be provided.
6. No milking animals eligible.

CODE OF ETHICS FOR HOLSTEIN EXHIBITORS

The following practices or procedures are considered unacceptable and defined as being unethical in the show ring of registered dairy cattle.

1. Misrepresenting the age of the animal for the class in which it is to be shown.
2. Minimizing the effect of crampiness by feeding or injecting drugs.
3. Surgery of any kind performed to change the natural contour of appearance of the animal's body, hide or hair. Not included is the removal of warts, teats and horns, clipping and dressing of hair and trimming of hooves.
4. Insertion of foreign materials under the skin, into the topline or on the feet.
5. Criticizing or interfering with the judge, show management or other exhibitors while in the show ring or other conduct detrimental to the breed or show.

8. Breeder's Herd (bred by exhibitor). A group of 3 animals, limited to one exhibit per exhibitor. Exhibitor must have bred all three animals and own at least two. Each animal must have been exhibited in one of the classes for single animals. The registration certificate for each respective animal must show the exhibitor as "breeder" and as "owner" – in both cases either as an individual or in partnership. In other words, the exhibitor may be a "joint owner" of the animal and/or "joint breeder" of an animal. **Class sponsored by Blue Wave Energy.**

PREMIER EXHIBITOR BANNER. An attractive Premier Exhibitor banner will be presented by **Syn Agri** to the individual, partnership or institution having the highest number of points that have been won in the individual classes for which prize money is offered by not more than ten animals owned by the exhibitor. This does not limit the number of animals that may be shown. In the case of jointly owned animals, points will be divided amongst the joint owners as shown on the registration certificate. Points will be awarded on the following basis: **1st – 10 points, 2nd – 9 points, 3rd – 8 points, 4th – 7 points, 5th – 6 points.**

PREMIER BREEDER BANNER. An attractive Premier Breeder banner will be presented by **Syn Agri** to the individual, partnership or institution having the highest number of points that have been won in the individual classes for which prize money is offered by not more than ten animals, bred but not necessarily owned by the winner. In the case of jointly bred animals, no part of points awarded will count toward the individual score for any of the joint breeders. Points will be awarded on the following basis: **1st – 10 points, 2nd – 9 points, 3rd – 8 points, 4th – 7 points, 5th – 6 points**
