1. Ages of the riders will be determined as of January 1st of the current year.
2. Under no circumstances will classes be delayed for exhibitors who are delayed by cross entries.
3. All exhibitors are to be dressed in clean suitable attire. Approved Head Gear is mandatory. All riders must wear proper fitting, approved protective headgear, with safety harness correctly secured at all times while mounted in competition or on event grounds. Approved head gear must meet the ASTM standards.
4. Any interference by a rider, parent, coach, trainer, or groom with the judge will result in elimination of the rider in question.
5. Ring numbers can be picked up at ringside before the show begins.
6. Exhibitors must show proof of liability insurance for the current year for all animals being shown. This is to accompany the entry forms and the entry forms will not be processed until this is received. All exhibitors will be required to sign a waiver when picking up numbers.
7. Each exhibitor must use a separate entry form.
8. The show committee reserves the right to withdraw any single class with less than three entries or any team class with less than two entries entered as of noon on the Thursday preceding the fair.
9. All entries close on **Wednesday September 09, 2026 at 4PM** unless otherwise stated. However if extenuating circumstances apply, entries after that date but before show day may be accepted at the discretion of the director in charge. A late entry fee of \$20.00 will apply.
10. All exhibitors must be members of the Society in order to exhibit.
11. **PARKING ON FAIR GROUNDS LIMITED TO TRAILERS AND TOWING VEHICLES. ALL EQUIPMENT MUST BE WITH THE ANIMALS AS THIS WILL BE THE ONLY VEHICLE ALLOWED ON THE GROUNDS.**
12. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to familiarize themselves with both the Rules and Regulations of the Fair and the Rules for the Light Horse Division.
13. Return of entry fees will only be considered by the Fair at the next Board meeting, if the show is cancelled or if the exhibitor presents a veterinarian or medical certificate.
14. Show management reserves the right to change order of go in the interest of the show before or during the show.
15. Exhibitors allowed 1 hold only, 3 minutes maximum in show. Exhibitors are responsible to be on time for their class. Be organized, plan ahead and bring helpers.
16. Stalls are available, only a small number. \$10 per day for use of the stall, must pre-book.

17. Each competitor is permitted one non-judged warm-up round in the ring prior to their division. No additional practice rounds will be allowed.
